Facility Set-Up/ Current Physical Assets

		Do you have the appropriate number of dock doors?*		
		Are staging areas large enough to accommodate cross docking needs?*		
		Does your facility have enough space available in the yard to manage trailer movement?		
		Are there any additional automated tools such as conveyors that will assist in optimizing the inventory flow throughout your facility?		
		The number of dock doors and space needed for staging will vary depending product assortment.		
Business Processes/ Expectations				
		Have you defined what products/ customers would benefit most from cross-docking? Consider metrics such as:		
		□ Demand		
		□ Lead time		
		□ Shipping frequency		
		Has your team considered new replenishment plans that may be needed for products included in cross-docking? You may need to:		
		Increase safety stock		
		 Adjust frequency of order fulfillment 		
		Are all stores located near a distribution center within your network?		

Ensure teams within your facility are aware of upcoming changes and
educate them as to how this will affect their current duties.

Current Software/ Technology

Does your WMS have the functionality to schedule and track shipments or is it integrated with your shipping management software?
Can your WMS provide you with historical data to select the best candidates for cross-docking?
Can your WMS quickly and easily adapt to changes?
Is inventory data viewable across the supply chain to assist in more efficient cross-docking execution?
Can your software and facility handle the processing and tracking of a higher number of smaller orders?
Does your technology integrate with automated tools (i.e. conveyors) utilized in the cross docking process?
